It has been said that Korea has five seasons: fall, winter, spring, summer, and rainy. As I write this letter (July 30), it is raining outside. It is always a joy when the rain comes as the temperature drops and it becomes more comfortable. The rain always makes me think of the familiar song, There Shall Be Showers of Blessings. I would like to share several blessings with you:

- Since we have been back in Korea, God has provided air conditioning units for our apartment. These have been such a blessing to us, especially at night.
- If you remember, there have been issues with our car due to its age and the new pollution control laws. We found out this month that we can have a pollution control device installed on the car. Upon the installation of the device, the status of the car changes and we NO LONGER have any pollution control restrictions. This is a fabulous blessing and will allow us to use our vehicle whenever we need it, not just on days of low pollution. This device costs between \$400 and \$600, but there are subsidies that might offset around 90% of the cost. We appreciate your prayers as we attempt to get this device installed. It would allow us to use our current vehicle at least through this term!
- God is blessing at Yongsan Baptist Church. We have started a church Facebook page and have begun streaming our services. God is blessing this part of the ministry and we have already seen a number of visitors as a result. Please keep us in prayer as we are consistently exceeding 70% of our available seating in the auditorium. We continue to pray regarding a move and appreciate your continued prayers for the situation with our building.

Again, thank you for your faithful prayers and support. You all are a blessing to us! Phil 4:17-18 "Not because I desire a gift: but I desire fruit that may abound to your account.
