We truly live in unprecedented times! The events of the past two months have been exciting, scary, and even difficult. It has forced many difficult decisions on part of both church leaders and government officials. Here in Korea, we began dealing with COVID-19 as a nation in mid—February. Since February 23rd, across Korea, social distancing has been the name of the game. This is difficult to achieve in one of the most densely populated cities on the planet. However, based on early data, it appears as if it has been successful! Hopefully, schools will reopen on April 6th (current plans but subject to change) and some of the restrictions will be lifted. Of course, this is dependent upon our case numbers continuing to go down.

So, how has this effected us? On a personal level, we have not had significant disruption to our normal daily schedule or ability to do things. The stores are all open, stocked, and we are able to get what we need. There have been adjustments that we have needed to make, but overall it has not been horrible. On a ministry perspective, things are a bit harder. We have not been able to do wide—scale distribution of tracts and John & Romans for the past few months. In addition, our attendance has been about 1/4 of normal. Please pray with us that the situation stabilizes and that those that have stopped coming due to the COVID-19 situation will resume.

You have probably heard the US State Department issued a level 4 world—wide travel advisory. After praying about it and discussing it with our pastor, **we have decided that it is best for us to remain in Korea at this time.** We appreciate your prayers as we continue to minister here! Please know that we are praying for each of you regularly!

Now for the other big news: **Lydia is expecting.** She is due on September 23rd and we are all very excited about this new addition to our family! The healthcare situation is stable and we have regular access to both doctors and hospitals if needed. We would appreciate your
